## 1933-1934 - past president 1937-1941 Kathryn S.Flohr

Beginning her political career in 1926 as President of the Lehigh County . IN 1934 she resignned her position following the ruling by the Treasury Department in which she was Deputy Collector of Inernal Revenue in Allentown.
