hold an official position in the Medical Society of Pennsylvania, 2nd Vice President

County.

Beginning her political career in 1926 as President of the Lehigh County. IN 1934 she resigned her position following the ruling by the Treasury Department in which she was Deputy Collector of Internal Revenue in **Allentown**.
